Instrumentation

Snare, Tenors, Crash Cymbals, Bass Drums, Bells, Xylophone, Tambourine, Suspended Cymbal, Cowbell, Ton's O' 20 and/or 30 gallon metal Trash Cans! (one per player) Plus one suspended crash cymbal per trash can

Set-Up:

The cans are set up on the side-line in a straight line with the players facing the audience.

For best projection, the cans should be placed upside-down with the edges resting on bricko blocks.

(The players strike the bottoms of the cans.) Each player will have a suspended crash cymbal on a stand directly in front of their can.
